

The Future Latino Leaders Law Camp is a nine-day summer enrichment program hosted by the HNBF each summer in Washington, DC. This year the program celebrated its 13th anniversary, providing 31 Latino high school students from across the country the opportunity to learn more about the legal profession. The Law Camp is a unique opportunity for students to gain valuable life skills, enhance public speaking abilities, meet successful Latino Leaders and tour important Federal institutions such as the U.S. Capitol, the U.S. Supreme Court and the Department of State. Students are housed on a college campus and gain valuable insights into the college admissions process, learn about careers in the legal profession and spend a week with other highly-motivated young Latino Leaders in the nation's capital. The students prepare and compete in a Mock Trial on the last day of the Camp, where they are able to showcase what they have learned throughout the week and celebrate team achievement. Some of the skills that the camp focuses on are team work, public speaking, critical thinking, productive argument and persuasion, and the ability to face challenging obstacles with enthusiasm, professionalism and confidence.
