## Blended Digital Courses

**Site:** Atholton High School  
**Dates:** June 25 – August 2  
MWF or TThF, 1:30pm – 4pm  
**Tuition:** \$550.00

All HCPSS Blended courses offer a hybrid of in-class and online coursework. These courses are teacher facilitated and are designed for students who are independent, competent readers **and motivated to learn in alternative formats**. Classes meet face-to-face with three days per week. Students are expected to complete extensive online coursework outside of class. **Blended courses require students to have reliable access to a computer and Internet connection outside of the classroom and have a valid e-mail address.** Registration for blended courses **ends June 15<sup>th</sup>** and will not be extended.

Students who are currently enrolled and have earned an “E” for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> quarters may register for ESS Credit Recovery classes **through home school counselors**. Students are required to complete Semester 1 coursework during 4<sup>th</sup> quarter at the homeschool and will complete Semester 2 coursework during Summer School.

## Registering for Summer School

To register for any CSS courses, complete the ONLINE registration form during any registration session.

Students needing assistance completing or accessing the online registration form may attend any on-site registration.

1. Go to the CSS Registration website between the 1<sup>st</sup>-15<sup>th</sup> of each month (Feb-June) – <http://tinyurl.com/HCPSSSummerSchool>
2. Click on “Register Here”
3. Complete the form and **submit**.

After completing the form, final enrollment is contingent upon (1) home school counselor approval and (2) full payment of tuition.

Scheduling letters with information about the program and student’s course(s), tuition, and balances will be mailed at the end of the month in which the student registers.

## Submitting Payment

An initial payment of 25% of course cost is due mailed by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month in which the student registers and full payment is due the following month.

**Mail-in Payments:** Send completed payment form with check made payable to HCPSS to the Summer School Office.

**Online Credit Card Payments:** Credit Card payments (MasterCard/VISA) can be made online. Visit the CSS Website and click the “Payments” tab at the top.

**On-Site Registrations and Payments:** Students needing assistance completing the registration form or wishing to drop off payments may attend any on-site registration. **No payments will be accepted at the Board of Education.**

## Financial Assistance

**Tuition Reduction -** Students currently receiving **Free and Reduced Meal Services (FARMS)** through HCPSS are eligible for 50% tuition reduction. Students apply for this by selecting “Yes” to the Tuition Reduction question on the registration form. No additional documentation is required.

**Scholarships** – Any student may apply for a scholarship of 50% off full or reduced tuition by demonstrating financial hardship. Send the “Financial Assistance Form” on website with **documentation** to the Summer School Office. The Financial Assistance Committee will review all requests at the end of each month and contact families directly. **No scholarships will be approved without documentation.** Students in Temporary Housing may request a Fee Waiver from their home school PPW.

## Closed Courses

Space in courses is limited. Students wishing to register for a closed course should complete the online wait list form at <http://tinyurl.com/csswaitlist2018>. Students on the wait list (regardless of circumstance or graduation status) are **not** guaranteed enrollment into the class. Should space become available, students on the waitlist will be contacted directly **VIA EMAIL**.

## Withdrawals and Course Changes

To withdraw from a course, complete the online withdrawal form at <http://tinyurl.com/csswithdraw2018>. Refunds may take up to 4-6 weeks. Submitting the withdrawal form is final. Students are removed from the course and their space may be filled. There is no guarantee the student will be able to re-enroll in that course. Students must withdraw prior to the first day of Summer School to receive a full refund.

**Course Transfers** – Students who have already completed the registration form and who wish to change or add classes should contact Ms. Shannon Reed, the registration administrator, at [Shannon\\_Reed@hcpss.org](mailto:Shannon_Reed@hcpss.org). You should not submit a withdrawal form or complete a second registration form. Multiple registration forms from the same student cannot be processed and will be invalidated.
