-Let your teachers know if you plan to be absent










WHAT PROBLEMS DO YOU WANT TO SOLVE WHEN YOU GROW UP?

referred to as Holland Codes or RIASEC (Career Key, 2015).


Was initially developed by American psychologist John L. Holland.






- 1. Make a list of your hobbies

- 7. Discover Your Core Values








